our standard and authority in all we say and do. We believe that God inspired the authors of the Bible to write what they wrote and therefore through their writings we can read what God wants us to understand and live out. The Bible is trustworthy and the final authority on all matters to which it speaks. We believe that God's unchangeable Biblical message ought to be presented free of religious jargon and understandable to the people of our community. The Bible, God's word to us, is central to our relationship with God and each other. The Bible makes clear that certain truths are essential convictions of the Christian faith. These Truths are the foundation on which we build our lives and our understanding of what "healthy" is. In Cognitive Behavioral Therapy, it is the Bible on which we formulate the Truth with which we reframe faulty thinking. About People and Salvation

All people are created with dignity and value in the image of God, to live in a vital relationship with God. However, through our sin, we break our intended relationship with God, fall short and we experience the destructive consequences of that broken relationship, spiritually and socially, in this life and beyond. However, God sent his Son, Jesus Christ, to rescue us from those eternal consequences and to restore our broken relationships with God and others, through Christ's death on the cross, a perfect act of redemption for each of us. Salvation comes to people on the basis of God's grace through their faith in Jesus alone. They receive the free gift of forgiveness and are spiritually reborn through repenting of their sin and believing in Jesus Christ. Good works and a holy life, although good, is totally unable to save anyone, but is the natural product of repentant and believing people seeking to please God. (I Peter 2:24; 3:18; Romans 3:9-28; 6:23; 10:9-10; John 3:16; 5:24; Ephesians 2:1-10; Titus 3:3-8; James 2:14-26)

How We Operate: Believers or Non-Believers

Truth: Jesus dined with non-believers.

We are all sinners. Some have accepted Jesus' offer to wear our shackles for us and to serve our sentence so we can be free. Others have chosen to hold out, choosing to continue wearing the shackles they don't realize they even have yet. That is the only difference between us; a choice. We are all equally sinners, equally "messed up", and equally broken in need of someone to save us from what we cannot save ourselves.

At Awaken360 we are sitting across from other believers who want to root into Truth found in His Word, and at times we are sitting across from someone who is still just like us. Only they are in life choosing not to accept His gift. We identify no matter what because we've all been there too. When our client has chosen not to accept the gift Jesus offers, we help them to identify the areas of their life that are jiving well, and the areas of their life they want to change and we help them find healthy living by rooting in the truth they identify.

What does AWAKEN360 believe about transgender and homosexuality?

Great question. Right now many non-believers are saying you should and can create your own reality. Christians are saying scripture proclaims homosexuality and transgender to be wrong, whereas other christians are quoting scripture saying scripture supports love in all forms.

AWAKEN360 first views anything that separates us from the God is sin. Example, alcohol is not inherently bad, but when alcohol compromises our character, changes our choices and reactions, and opens a door to further separation from living the life designed for us, then in that moment, alcohol becomes an anchor for separation from the life we were created to live and the mission we are here to accomplish. We view sin as sin, and we all fall short of living perfectly. In short and more directly, Awaken360 believes the Bible is very clear regarding the slippery-slope sin creates; sexual sin being no different. Awaken360 views biblical marriage to be between a man and a woman. Sex is safest and is healthy when it occurs within the structure of a healthy marriage commitment between a man and a woman. Scripture speaks clearly, repeatedly, and consistently to this view and our biology testifies to its truth. That being said, we work with clients from every walk of life. This may be something you have chosen to live by and do not view it as wrong. We at Awaken360 still want to dine with you and encourage you to still want to dine with you. At then end of the day, you're not perfect and neither are we. We are all people trying to make a way in this world. We've chosen to accept the gift Jesus offers. You may not have.
